

# **Membership Requirements**

#### TIME COMMITMENT

The Rotary Club of Sacramento is able to make a significant impact in our community due to the active involvement of our members. While recognizing that all community leaders have busy schedules, the Rotary Club of Sacramento is a service organization and all members are expected to actively participate.

### **Tuesday Lunch Meetings**

A minimum attendance rate of 50% is expected at weekly lunch meetings. Meetings can be made up at other clubs. With weeks off for holidays and events, there are a total of 40 lunch meetings each year.

### **Sacramento Century Challenge**

Volunteers are essential for the success of the Sac Century. Please hold the first Saturday of October each year and plan to spend the full day volunteering.

#### **Golf 4 Kids Fundraiser**

Taking place each May, we encourage you to golf or volunteer.

#### Service

Participate in volunteer opportunities in our community throughout the year such as Loaves and Fishes or American River Parkway clean up days. Serve our club through involvement on one of the many committees. These opportunities vary throughout the year and can be selected to fit your schedule.

# **Annual Dues**

### **Individual Membership**

\$1,945

Annual dues for individual members are billed quarterly and include all weekly lunches, happy hours, and firesides. Other fee-based events are invoiced separately.

Group Membership \$1,500/person

Minimum of 2 people from the same organization. Annual dues are billed once at the start of the fiscal year and include 20 meals/person. After 20 meals, lunches attended are \$30 each. Dues include happy hours and firesides. Other fee-based events are invoiced separately.

Young Professionals \$610 + lunches

Annual dues for young professionals are billed quarterly. Dues do not include fees for weekly luncheons (\$30 for each lunch attended), happy hours, firesides, or other fee-based events. All will be invoiced separately.

# **Additional Optional Expenses**

#### **Foundation Contributions**

\$200

Members are strongly encouraged to give an annual contribution to both the Rotary Club of Sacramento Foundation and the Rotary International Foundation. A minimum donation of \$100 to each foundation is recommended.

# **Golf 4 Kids Tournament**

\$50+

Begun in 1922, this is the oldest continuous fundraising project in Rotary. Participate as a golfer, sponsor, and/or tee sponsor. Proceeds fund programs for physically disabled students through a number of local schools and organizations.

### **Sacramento Century Challenge**

\$50+

This annual cycling fundraiser has been held for 9 years and supports a selected local nonprofit. Financial and volunteer support from members is essential to the success of this event.

### **Meeting Sponsorship**

\$350

Includes a lunch ticket for your guest, a commercial announcement at the meeting, the opportunity to put up a display and distribute flyers, as well as recognition in Rotary's weekly newsletter, *The Pulse*.

#### Wine Reception Sponsorship

Sponsor the weekly Wine Reception by bringing and pouring your favorite wine.
